


Figure 1. Examples of stimuli used in the experiment. Chapter 5, p. 95




Figure 1. Schematic representation of the task with illustration of incongruent and congruent trials for Dutch and English colored words. For colored words, participants were required to make their response based on the color of the presented word (the actual response). The tendency comes from a common/neuter gender decision they had to make for white words. Note that colors used in the figure are not the actual colors used in the experiment but close approximation there off. Chapter 6, p. 120
