This critical edition covers the first two parts of the work *De secundis intentionibus* by Hervaeus Natalis. The introduction provides background information about the chronological and philosophical context of this work. At the beginning of the 14th century, the exact meaning and use of the *species intelligibilis* and the *intentio* formed an important theme in the philosophical discussions about ontology, epistemology and logic. Hervaeus was the first to write an extensive and influential treatise on intentions. Compared to the existing theories of, for instance, Thomas Aquinas, Hervaeus offers a new approach to the subject, complete with many subtle and complex details of interpretation and definition.
