## Destruction, Regeneration and Replacement of Beta-cells and Aspects of Immune-intervention in Type 1 Diabetes

- Insulitic lesions cannot recruit T-cells in the absence of local cognate pMHC (this thesis).
- 2. Cell lineage tracing models in NOD mice are a novel tool in type 1 diabetes research but as regenerative pathways might differ between species, regeneration studies should be translated with prudence (this thesis).
- 3. Recurrent diabetes in a syngeneic islet cell transplantation model is driven by memory autoreactive T-cells (this thesis).
- 4. Downregulation of MHC-I expression combined with inhibition of the cytotoxic granzyme B pathway via US2/ Serpin 9 expression does not impact islet viability *in vivo* and protects beta-cells from autoimmune CTL attack (this thesis).
- 5. Recall immunity in recent onset T1DM patients is preserved in spite of high-dose anti-CD3 treatment (this thesis).
- 6. We are more likely to win this particular war by gaining the insight needed to negotiate with the immune system than by seeking to bomb it into submission (Edwin Gale, N Engl J Med 2002;346:1740-1742).
- 7. Indicators of quality of clinical care (such as HbA1c) are not a quality of life indicator for patients with diabetes.
- 8. Patients with an inborn error of metabolism fail to currently receive the attention they deserve from general physicians.
