Elke Krekels was born on July 17, 1981 in Enschede, The Netherlands. In 1993 she started her secondary education at the Twents Carmellyceum in Oldenzaal, The Netherlands. She received her 'VWO-diploma' in 2000, after also spending one year in as a foreign exchange student at the Edwardsville High School in Edwardsville IL, USA. Elke started her studies of Bio-Pharmaceutical Sciences at Leiden University in Leiden, The Netherlands in September 2000 and during these studies she developed a keen interest in population

PKPD modeling.
