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Propositions belonging to the thesis

The influence of morbid obesity on the pharmacokinetics and pharmacodynamics of drugs in adolescents and adults.

Focus on propofol and nadroparin.

- 1. For propofol-remifentanil anaesthesia in morbidly obese patients, propofol infusion rates should be based on adjusted body weight defined as: 70 kg * (total body weight/70 kg)^{0.72}. *This thesis*
- 2. Prediction of propofol clearance in adults and children requires consideration of both total body weight and age as covariates. *This thesis*
- 3. Lean body weight should be used as scalar for individualized dosing of low-molecular-weight heparines in morbidly obese patients. *This thesis*
- 4. The complexity of thrombosis prophylaxis in morbidly obese patients necessitates the formation of a multidisciplinary expert opinion group. *This thesis*
- 5. Obese individuals do not differ from non-obese individuals by being 'larger' but by having excess body fat, and therefore the allometry law cannot be used for obese individuals in advance. *DJ Eleveld et al. Clin Pharmacokinet*. 2011;50(11):751-3
- 6. A prospective clinical study is the final step towards the implementation of novel dosing algorithms.
- 7. Collaboration between the anaesthesiologists, surgeons and clinical pharmacists is crucial when performing clinical pharmacology studies in morbidly obese patients.
- 8. As an expert regarding the safe use of drugs, the clinical pharmacist plays an important role in the application of new algorithms for the individualization of dosing regimens in clinical practice.
- 9. NONMEM has in common with a hospital organization that both should be encouraged to think more outside of the box.
