## Curriculum Vitae

Maral Jefroudi was born in 1982 in Tehran. She grew up in Istanbul, Turkey and graduated from Kadıköy Anadolu Lisesi. She has a double-major degree with High Honours from the departments of Political Science and International Relations, and Sociology at Boğaziçi University. She completed her thesis *A Re-politicized History of Iranian Transit Migrants Passing Through Turkey in the 1980s* and received her M.A. degree in 2008 from Atatürk Institute for Modern Turkish History, Boğaziçi University. She taught Modern Turkish History in Boğaziçi University between 2008-2010. In 2010 She received the Fox International Fellowship at Yale University. Between 2010 and 2014, she worked as a PhD researcher at the International Institute of Social History and at the same time enrolled in the PhD programme at LIAS, Leiden University. In 2013, she received the Weatherhead Initiative on Global History (WIGH) fellowship at Harvard University. She has taught the course *The Precariat* with Marcel van der Linden at the Research Master's in Social Sciences programme in the University of Amsterdam since 2015. She has translated books and articles from Persian and English into Turkish. Since 2014 she is co-director at the International Institute of Research and Education in Amsterdam.
