He then completed a degree in Ethnomusicology at the Escola Superior de Música de Catalunya (Barcelona, 2012), and a degree in Language Sciences at Université Paris 8 (2012). From 2013 to 2017 he has been employed by Leiden University in order to perform doctoral research within the project *Knowledge and culture*, on the role of core knowledge systems in shaping the versification systems of the world. This work has been conducted primarily at the Meertens Instituut (Amsterdam), under the supervision of Marc van Oostendorp and Johan Rooryck, with a visiting period at the Australian National University (Canberra). While working on his thesis, he has performed teaching duties at Leiden University on phonetics, phonology and syntax.
