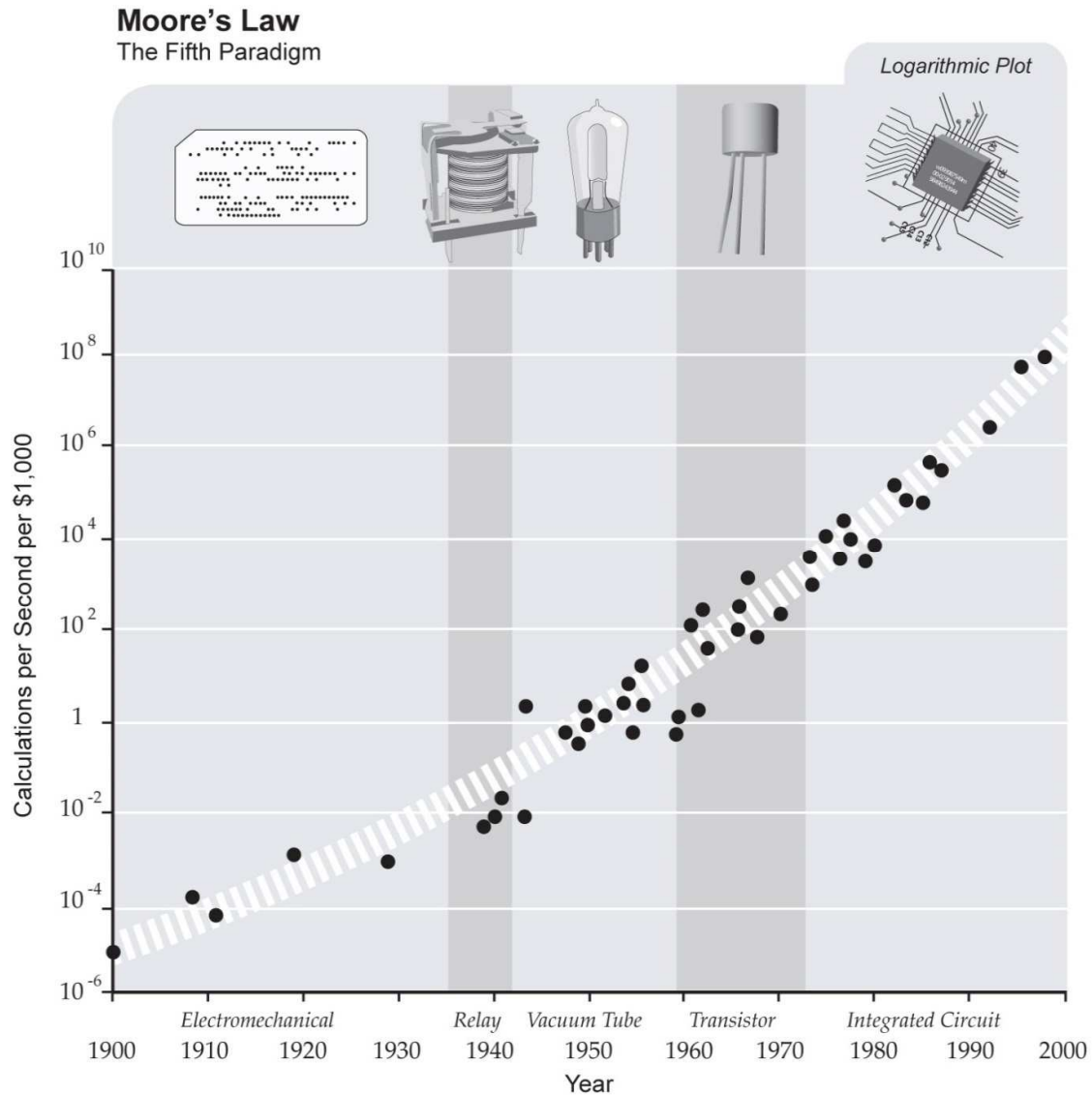

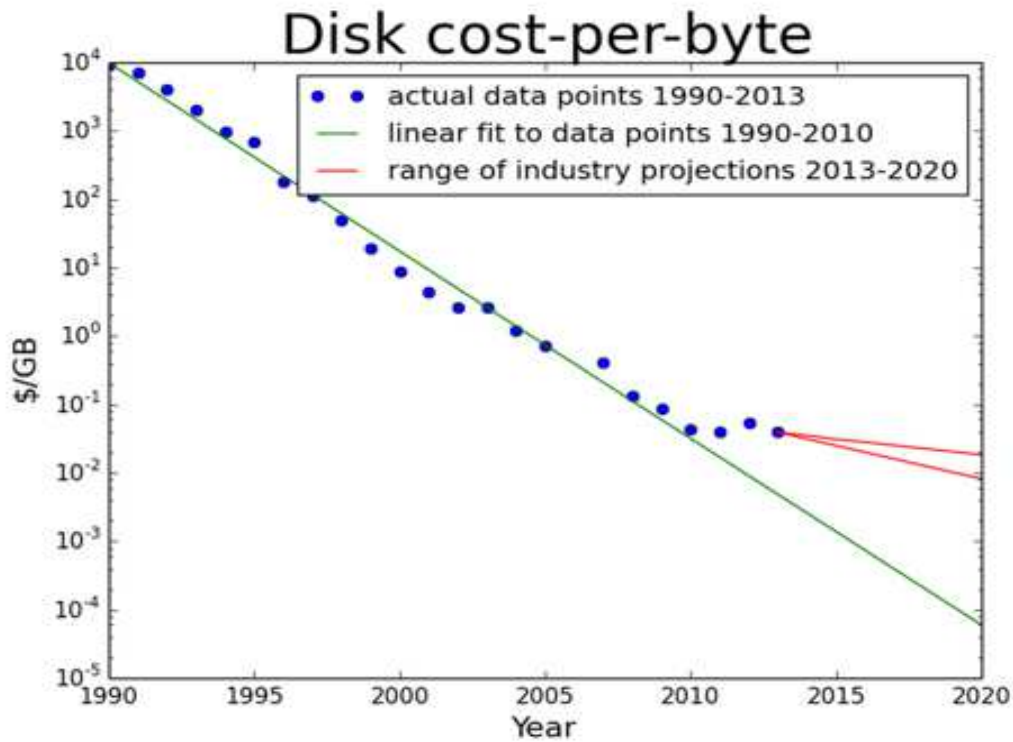

Appendix 1. The Natural Laws of the Digital Universe: Processing power⁵⁷¹



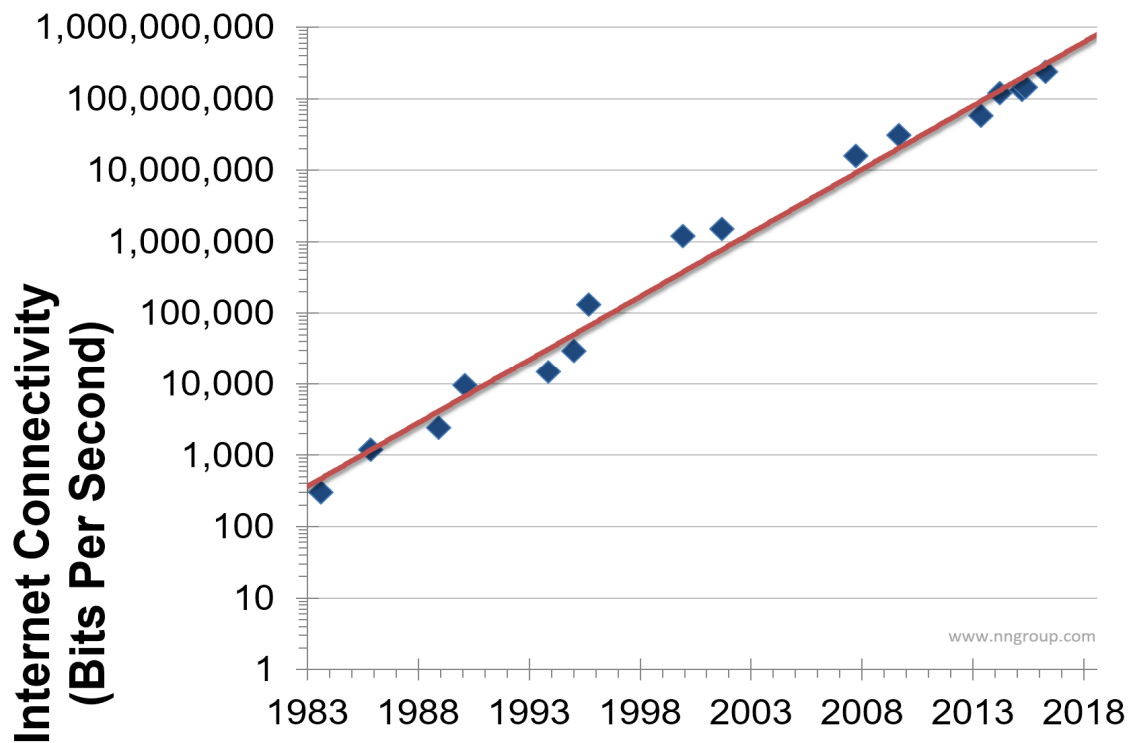
