





Company, the Beira & Mashonaland railways make connection with the Portuguese East African Railway. This is the railway which operates over the Lower Zambesi River Bridge, about 130 miles north of this junction, which has been pictured in both 1935 and 1937 on the stamps of the Mozambique Company.”
