QUALITY ASSURANCE IN THE SURGICAL TREATMENT OF GASTRIC CANCER

Yvette H.M. Claassen

- 1. The intended high surgical quality program in the CRITICS trial has succeeded and should be considered as an example for future gastric cancer trials. (this thesis)
- 2. Upfront randomization in the CRITICS gastric cancer trial did not influence the quality of surgery. (this thesis)
- 3. There is an indisputable effect of hospital volume on short- and long term outcomes of gastric cancer. (this thesis)
- 4. The substantial treatment and survival differences in elderly and metastatic (stage IV) gastric cancer patients between the European countries underline the need for more international collaboration. (this thesis)
- 5. A strict surgical quality program should be mandatory in the study protocol of each randomized clinical trial (concerning gastric cancer) with a surgical intervention.
- 6. Randomized clinical trials for gastric cancer should focus on the optimal approach for neo-adjuvant therapy instead of adjuvant therapy.
- 7. Limitations of randomized clinical trials should be acknowledged and population based cohort studies should be valued more.
- 8. Centralisation of gastric cancer surgery as part of a multidisciplinary team in the Netherlands is an essential element in improving outcomes for gastric cancer patients.
