CURRICULUM VITAE

Jan van den Berg (The Hague, 1951) received his pre-University education in The Hague (Gymnasium Bèta; diploma 1969). From 1969 till 1977 he studied Theology at the Free University of Amsterdam (principal subject: Old Testament studies), receiving his Master diploma in 1977.

He started his professional career as teacher of Religion at the Secondary School ‘Melanchthon’ in Rotterdam where he worked from 1977 till 1983.

In 1983 he was sent out by the Reformed Churches in the Netherlands to teach Old Testament studies at the post-graduate School for Theology of the Methodist University of São Paulo in Brazil. During the following years, up till 1989, he was also Minister of the Dutch Protestant Church in São Paulo.

After his return to Europe he became Minister of the Protestant Church in Oss in the Netherlands from 1990 till 1994. Finally, from 1995 till 2016, he was Minister of the Protestant Church in Brasschaat (Belgium).

In 2011 he was accepted as an external PhD researcher at Leiden University, working on a dissertation on the eighteenth-century Christian Deist Thomas Morgan under the supervision of Prof Ernestine van der Wall and dr Jan Wim Buisman.

He retired in 2016, and is living in Ekeren (Belgium).
