## LIFTING THE FOG OF NEUROPSYCHIATRIC LUPUS

- 1. Classification criteria have drawbacks in rare disease manifestations. (*this thesis*)
- 2. Symptomatic therapy suffices in the majority of patients with systemic lupus erythematosus presenting with neuropsychiatric symptoms. (*this thesis*)
- 3. Neuropsychiatric symptoms in patients with systemic lupus erythematosus lead to suffering, but not to death. (*this thesis*) (this thesis)
- 4. Improving quality of life in patients with systemic lupus erythematosus and neuropsychiatric symptoms must include focus on anxiety, mood and fatigue. (this thesis)
- 5. The ACR Nomenclature of neuropsychiatric systemic lupus erythematosus no longer holds.
- 6. The only way to lift the fog of neuropsychiatric systemic lupus erythematosus is multicenter collaboration.
- 7. The presence of white matter hyperintensities should be an active lead to consider treatment initiation in patients with systemic lupus erythematosus.
- 8. Effectiveness of interventions should primarily be based on outcomes relevant for patients.
- 9. The world is not black and white, but shades of gray that we try to color.
- 10. Research should only be conducted by those who are willing to accept all possible outcomes.
- 11. Communicating research findings is a balancing act of precision and persuasion.
- 12. Coping is the cure to everything.
