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Backcover: The cover shows a schematic illustration of self-assembled flexible colloidal molecules and lattices made from colloidal particles functionalized with surface-mobile DNA (depicted in magenta and green colors) and rigid colloidal molecules formed from oppositely charged colloidal particles (depicted in grey and red colors).
