Functional study of the human genome

- 1. CRISPRko and CRISPRa libraries are robust to identify the potential transporters of doxorubicin. (This thesis)
- 2. K562 clones with CRISPRa-mediated upregulation of ABCB1 gene become more resistant to doxorubicin and other anthracycline drugs. (This thesis)
- 3. SLC2A3 gene serves as a novel doxorubicin importer and response marker. (This thesis)
- 4. Dual-CRISPR system is capable of interrogating both previously annotated and unannotated non-coding genomic elements in an unbiased fashion. (This thesis)
- 5. Ultraconserved non-coding elements which regulate a cascade of gene pathways affecting cell growth were identified. (This thesis)
- 6. Two Non-coding regulatory elements function as silencers and contribute to survival advantages during imatinib treatment. (This thesis)
- 7. Essential enhancer regions and related genes which cause decreased cell growth were identified. (This thesis)
- 8. Dual-CRISPR screening system is also capable of capturing clusters of NCREs with redundant biological functions. (This thesis)
- 9. Potential genes which are regulated by NCREs were identified by the combination of dual-CRISPR screening and scRNA-seq. (This thesis)
- 10. PAX6_Tarzan may be a potential silencer and involve in cardiomyocyte differentiation via regulation of surrounding genes and possibly other genes that are key to heart development and physiology. (This thesis)
