Sexual health care in prostate cancer for men and their partners

1. Patients indicated that adequate information provision and satisfactory interaction with their healthcare providers helped them dealing with changes in their sexuality (dit proefschrift).
2. Prostate cancer has been described as a ‘relationship disease’ (dit proefschrift).
3. It may not be assumed that all healthcare professionals are able to practice sexual medicine. Establishing an adequate referral system in outpatient clinics should enable them to refer patients to specialized healthcare professionals (dit proefschrift).
4. Future research should ensure that the sample reflects the characteristics of our population, since traditional views on gender and sexual orientation were used (dit proefschrift).
5. ‘A clinician-initiated discussion should be conducted with the patient and the partner (if partnered and culturally appropriate), about realistic expectations of the impact of prostate cancer therapy on the patient’s sexual function, the partner’s sexual experience, and the couples’ sexual relationship.’ (Wittmann et al. *J Sex Med.* 2022 Nov;19(11):1655-1669)
