# ACUTE PANCREATITIS

## FROM TREATMENT TO PREVENTION

1. A postponed drainage approach for the management of infected necrotizing pancreatitis should be preferred - this thesis
2. The therapeutic role of anticoagulation for splanchnic vein thrombosis in acute pancreatitis is unknown - this thesis
3. After a first episode of acute pancreatitis, one in four patients will develop recurrent pancreatitis, chronic pancreatitis, or pancreatic cancer - this thesis
4. Gallstones in patients with suspected acute alcoholic pancreatitis increase the risk of recurrent acute pancreatitis, whereas cholecystectomy reduces this risk - this thesis
5. Medical attention often focuses on the symptomatic treatment of acute alcoholic pancreatitis and neglects the underlying problem of problematic alcohol use - this thesis
6. A multidisciplinary and multicenter approach lead to improved clinical outcomes and better quality control in clinical studies - Dutch Pancreatitis Study Group
