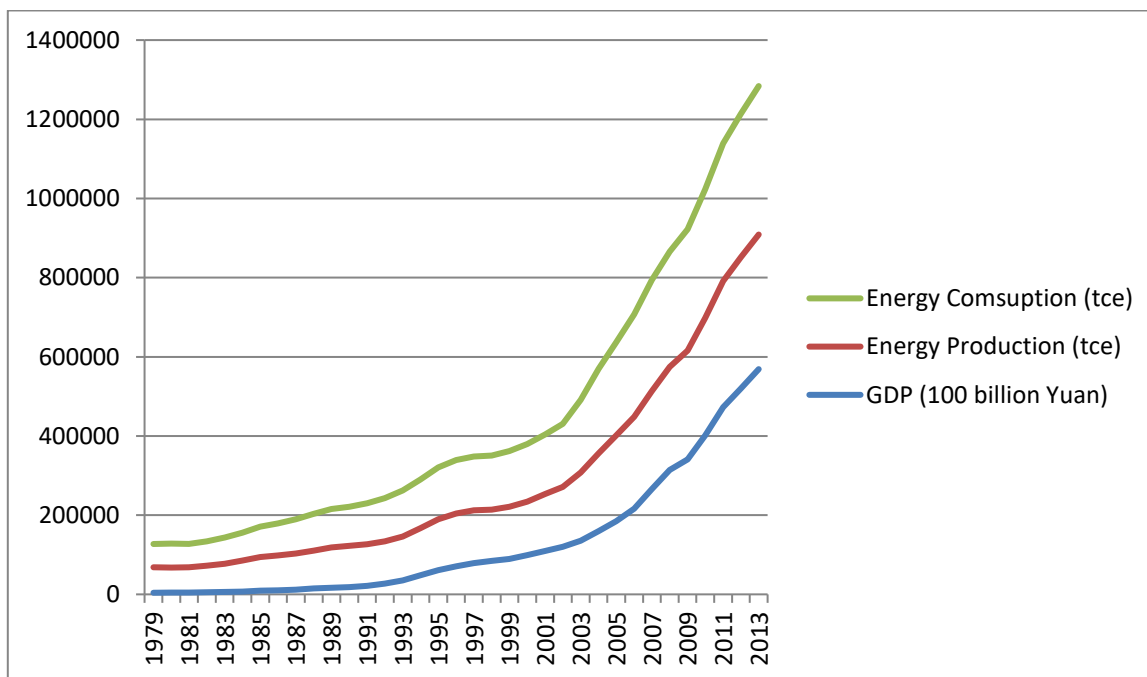

Table 1 Energy Consumption, Energy Production and GDP (1979-2013)



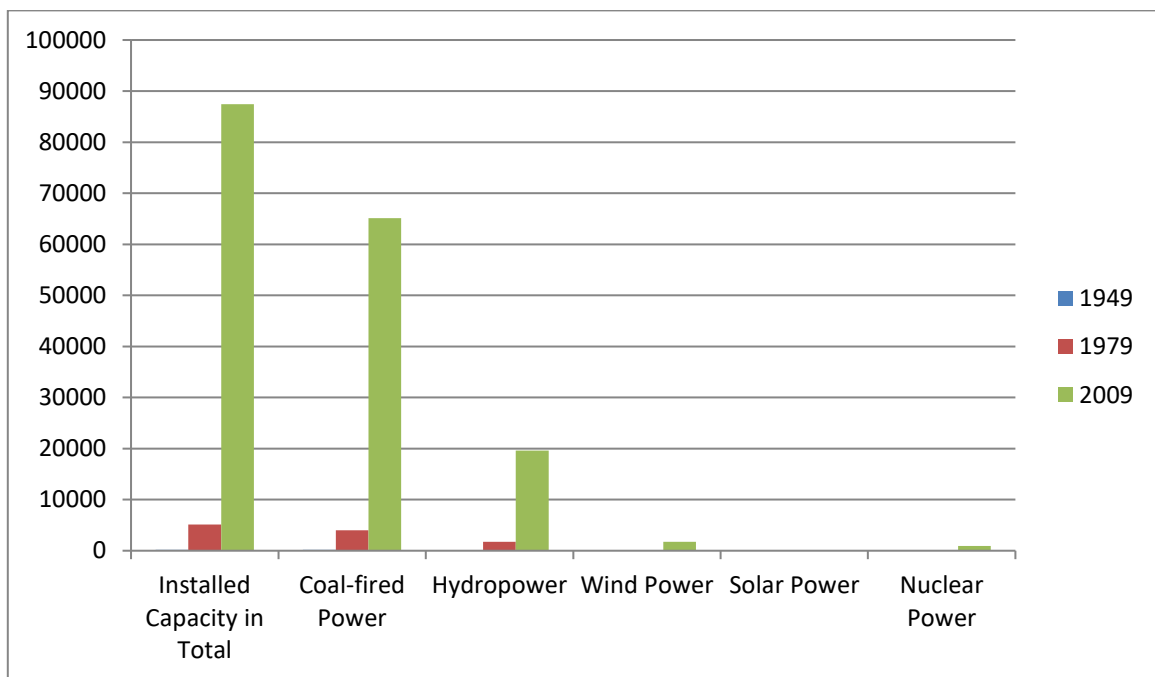

Appendix D: The Reform of 2002 in China's Electricity Industry

China's electricity industry underwent a significant change around 2002. Document No. 5, the plan for reforming the electricity industry promulgated by the State Council, has long been regarded as a milestone in China's energy sector. According to this plan, a series of reforms would be carried out. Primary reform measures included:

Separating electricity plants from electricity grids.

Constructing regional electricity markets.

Setting up professional electricity regulatory institutions.¹⁰¹⁴

Based on these measures, the core objective of this round of reform was to promote the role of the market in industrial development and to apply adequate supervision of the electricity industry. However, this plan resulted in an oligopoly instead of a competitive market.

Electricity Crisis and Price Setting in the Grid

Reform is not motivated but always occurs because of crisis. The electricity crisis around 2002 called for a new round of reform.

China's electricity deficiency in the early 2000s was the most severe electricity crisis since 1949. In it, many enterprises experienced a shortage of electricity. Some small plants or factories were obliged to stop production or even became bankrupt. Residents in several provinces had to live without the usual sources of modern entertainment and convenience (e.g., television, lighting, and refrigeration) for two or three days every week. The retail price was then raised to encourage electricity production. Much work was needed to balance supply and demand.

The reason why this crisis happened has long been debated among Chinese scholars. Nevertheless, hardly anyone denies that the different price systems between coal and electricity were a factor. The dominant coal, electricity, and transportation coalition structurally

determined the electricity crisis. Since the coal price was set by the market but the electricity price by the government, the fixed electricity price had to adjust to the fluctuating price of coal, which was the primary fuel for electricity production. The differences between the two prices produced rent. The rent created was allocated. When the electricity price was much lower than coal, rent would transfer from electricity to coal. In an extreme case, when this loss of rent could not be recovered by raising the electricity price, electricity producers could reduce production. Therefore, an electricity shortage would unavoidably happen. An electricity excess followed the same logic. It was the mechanism of a two-price system that caused the electricity crisis.¹⁰¹⁵

The dominant coalition of coal, electricity, and transportation kept working to coordinate this two-price system. It tried to fix the two prices so electricity and coal could share profit in the long run. To achieve this, the dominant coalition required the producers of electricity and coal to sign a contract. The contract price was not regulated by the state but negotiated by the two contracting parties. However, because the coal price increased radically, it took time and effort to arrive at a price that satisfied the wishes of both parties. To help this dominant coalition to work, the NDRC sometimes introduced subsidies created as rent for the producers of electricity and coal to facilitate a compromise.¹⁰¹⁶ But the scale of this subsidy was small, so they still needed help to cover the loss. As a result, when the price of transportation was controlled, the two segments of coal and electricity in the dominant coalition of coal, electricity, and transportation came into conflict with each other, making the current electricity crisis even worse.

Price setting was an essential factor in explaining the electricity crisis. Still, this crisis had its institutional roots in the state structure, where the interaction between the dominant coalition and the Tiaokuai structure defined the contents of industrial policy. To simplify the analysis, we approach the issue from the angle that the related industrial policymaking was a compromise reached by the central government, the local government, and the coal-electricity-transportation coalition.

Obstacles in Marketization

To initiate this reform, more concern was given to the blueprint of international experience than to the natural obstacles presented by the Tiaokuai structure. According to the State Electricity Regulatory Commission, the Ministry of Finance, and the World Bank, four models could be categorized for China's electricity sector structure.¹⁰¹⁷ The first was the administrative monopoly before 1985. The government directly or indirectly controlled all the generation, transmission, and distribution agencies. The second was that only a single buyer could buy from electricity producers in competition in an area. China adopted this between 1984 and 2002, during which electricity generation was relatively independent while the transmission section still owned the distribution section. The third was that the distribution section and large end-users could purchase from competitive generators. The fourth was to develop a competitive structure with a clear division between generation, transmission, and distribution. In this structure, transmission and distribution would be independent of each other and privatized into a wholesale market and a retail market, respectively. The recommendation to marketize China's electricity industry focused on allowing model 2 to transform into model 3 to achieve model 4 in the future. This orientation of marketization was meant to replace a monopoly as the primary mechanism to allocate resources.¹⁰¹⁸ If this approach had been adopted, a free market in China's electricity industry would have been achieved. However, as will be examined below, it underestimated the obstacles within the Tiaokuai structure, especially the interaction between this structure and the oligopoly.¹⁰¹⁹

The first obstacle was conflict among the agencies in the State Council. These agencies included the NDRC, the SASAC and the State Electricity Regulatory Commission (SERC). Although it was suggested in the report that an independent SERC with effective authority to supervise the power sector and regulate the electricity market was critically important in a market-orientated reform, the feasibility of forming such an agency should have been mentioned. Provided that the NDRC was the "General Manager" of the SOEs and the SASAC the "Chairman of the Board," there was so little space left for the SERC that it became embarrassed. It would function like an executive officer rather than a commander or inspector

holding a superior position to the two other ministries.¹⁰²⁰ As a result, the stamp (signature) of the SERC had to be approved by the NDRC and the SASAC.¹⁰²¹

The second obstacle was an internal contradiction of policymaking in the State Council itself. The State Council employed both a declared policy and an ad hoc policy. The internal rejection of these two policies lay in the political power arrangement between the State Council and the Politburo of the CCP. The State Council generally preferred economics to politics, while the Politburo preferred the opposite. In such a context, although the SERC attempted to carry out the policy of the market plan of 2002, this attempt would be interrupted or postponed by the ad hoc policy of the State Council. This was because the State Council had to pay more attention to the suggestion of the Politburo, the priority of which justified the implementation of the declared policy and the initiation of the ad hoc policy. The two approaches struggled to reach a compromise or fell into a deadlock, weakening the capacity of the SERC. In addition, the self-contradiction of the two policies further deprived the SERC of the authority to represent the State Council in supervising the market players, paralyzing the whole system.¹⁰²²

The third obstacle came directly from the challenge of the State Grid. It was a conglomerate. It attempted to monopolize the national grid market. This monopolization could restrict the engagement of the SERC in supervision because the State Grid enjoyed the authority to set a buying price and quota for producers and a selling price for consumers. Although there were two other grid companies, namely the South China Grid and the Western Inner Mongolia Grid but their controls were limited to their domains. This made them cooperative rather than opponents in most aspects of challenging the supervision of the SERC. Even though these two independent grids conflicted with State Grid, they were deeply concerned about losing their monopoly rent, resulting in a typical inclination against any proposal for a free market. For example, the State Grid and the South China Grid were ambitious in carrying out the UHVTP. However, the former aimed to technically monopolize the national networks while the latter prepared to fight against this monopolization. When these two oligopolies faced the risk of fragmented competitiveness, they were drawn into an integrated and dominant interest group, trying to ignore their disputes.

The fourth obstacle was nothing but local protectionism. Local governments owned more

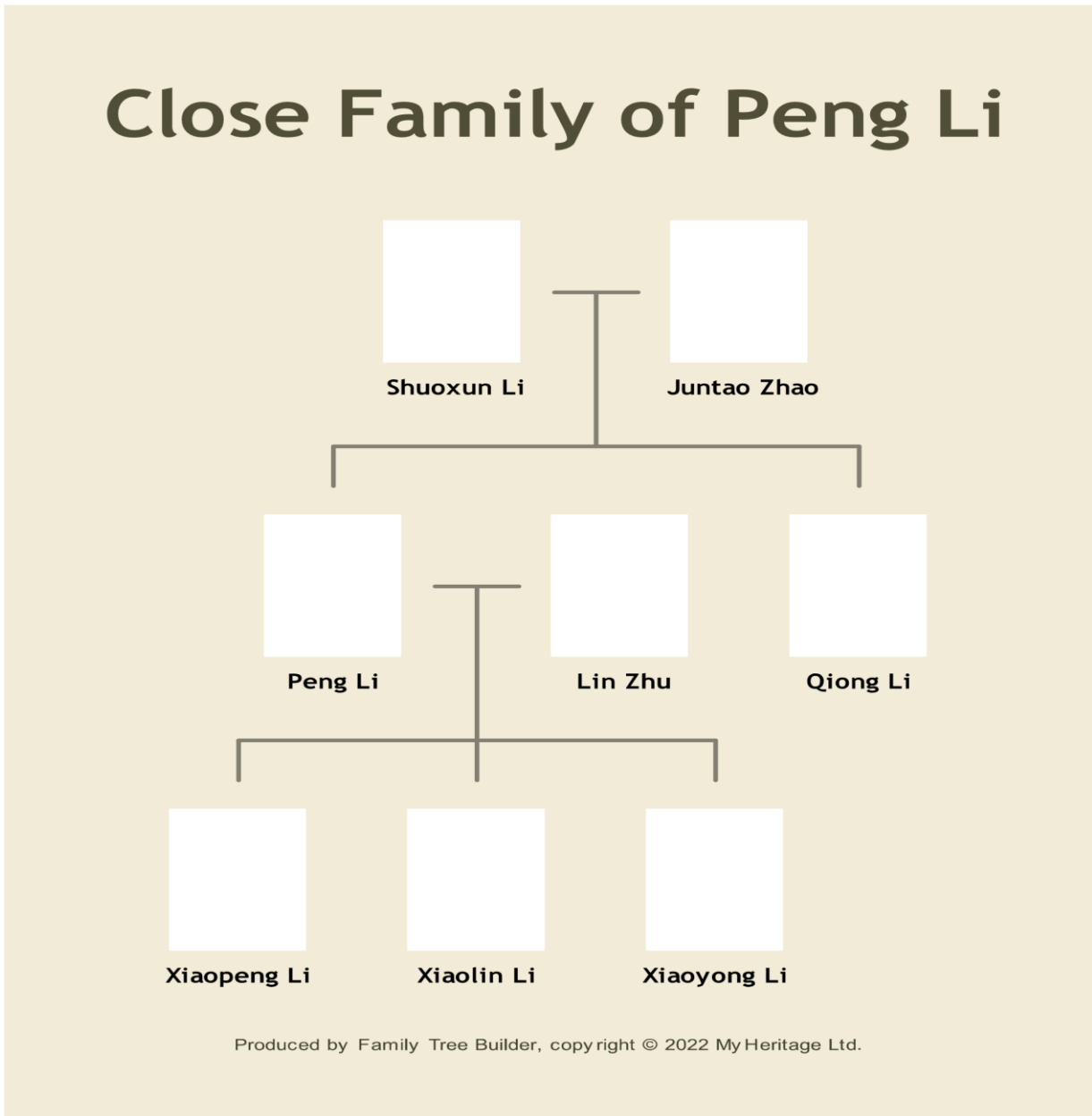
than 30% of the national generation market share and some suburban and rural distribution lines. With such assets, the local governments could afford any excuse to act following their own will and disobey the orders or rules of the SERC. Widespread local protectionism was hardly rooted out. Because of this local protectionism, the anticipated result was that the suggested branches of the SERC in the report written by the SERC, the Ministry of Finance and the World Bank would be no more than bystanders if they were set up. Even with the expected local branches, the central SERC could still be blinded because of the possible fraudulent information provided by the local governments. This was because the interests of the local governments were intertwined with those of the local branches of Ministries and central banks, and fraudulent information served to blind the supervision of the central government in favour of their interests at the local level. Such blindness to the data could deepen the SERC's misunderstanding of what happened at the local level.

All these obstacles were related to the institutions in China, which could hardly be changed by a newly established agency like the SERC. More importantly, these obstacles indicated that rent-seeking activities were conducted by the players mentioned above. Unfortunately, the SERC needed to be more potent to exercise political power either to stop this game or become involved in it as an eligible player. So, the timetable of the market-orientated agenda in Document No. 5 encountered difficulties in implementation after 2002. This resulted in an undesirable electricity market with fewer fragmented competition elements and more oligopoly characteristics. The SERC planned to legalize itself by promoting a new electricity law to keep going on. However, it only survived before submitting the proposal.¹⁰²³ It was dissolved on 18 March 2013.¹⁰²⁴
