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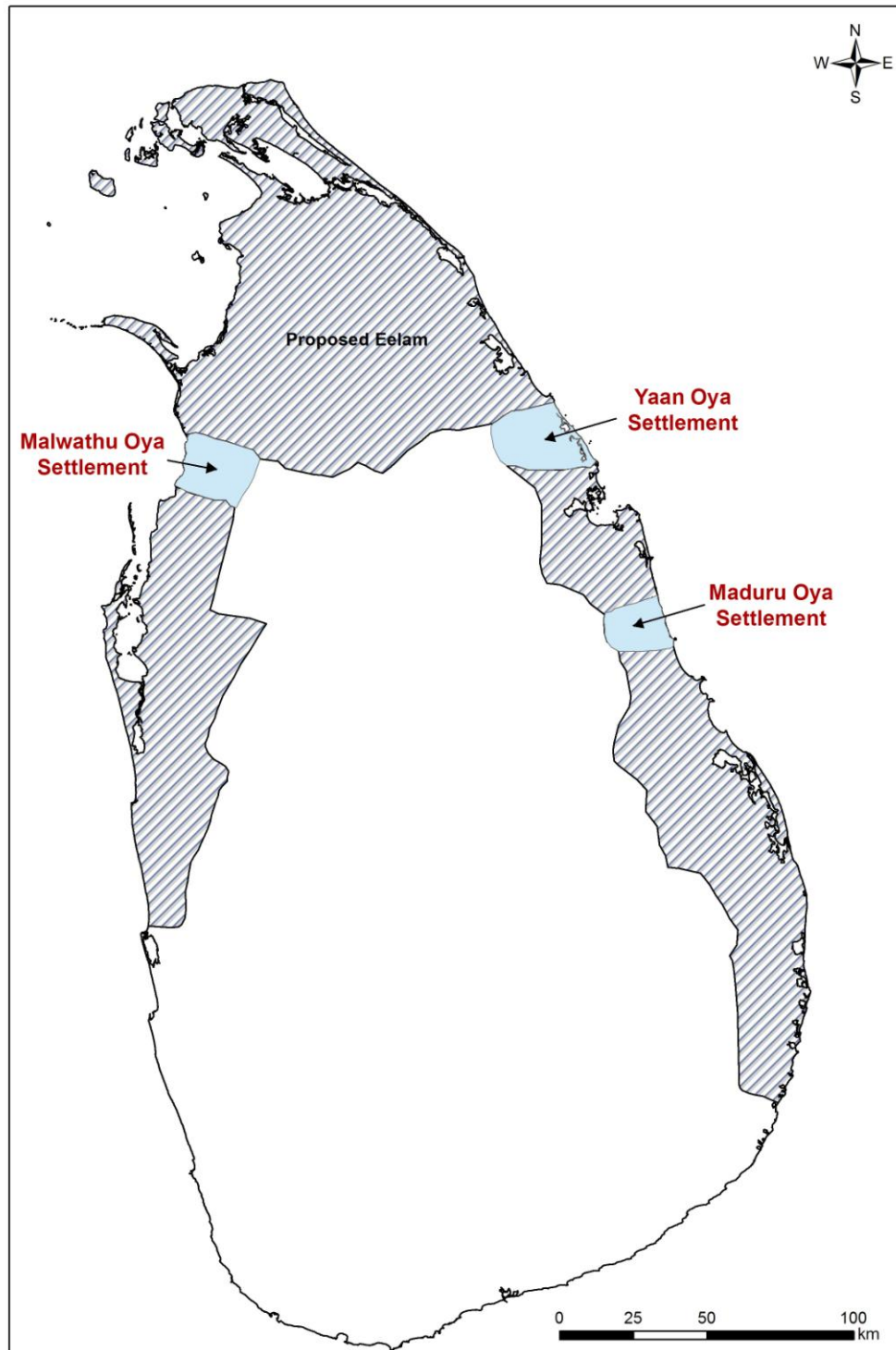

Map 1: Yaan Oya – Malwathu Oya – Maduru Oya Operation

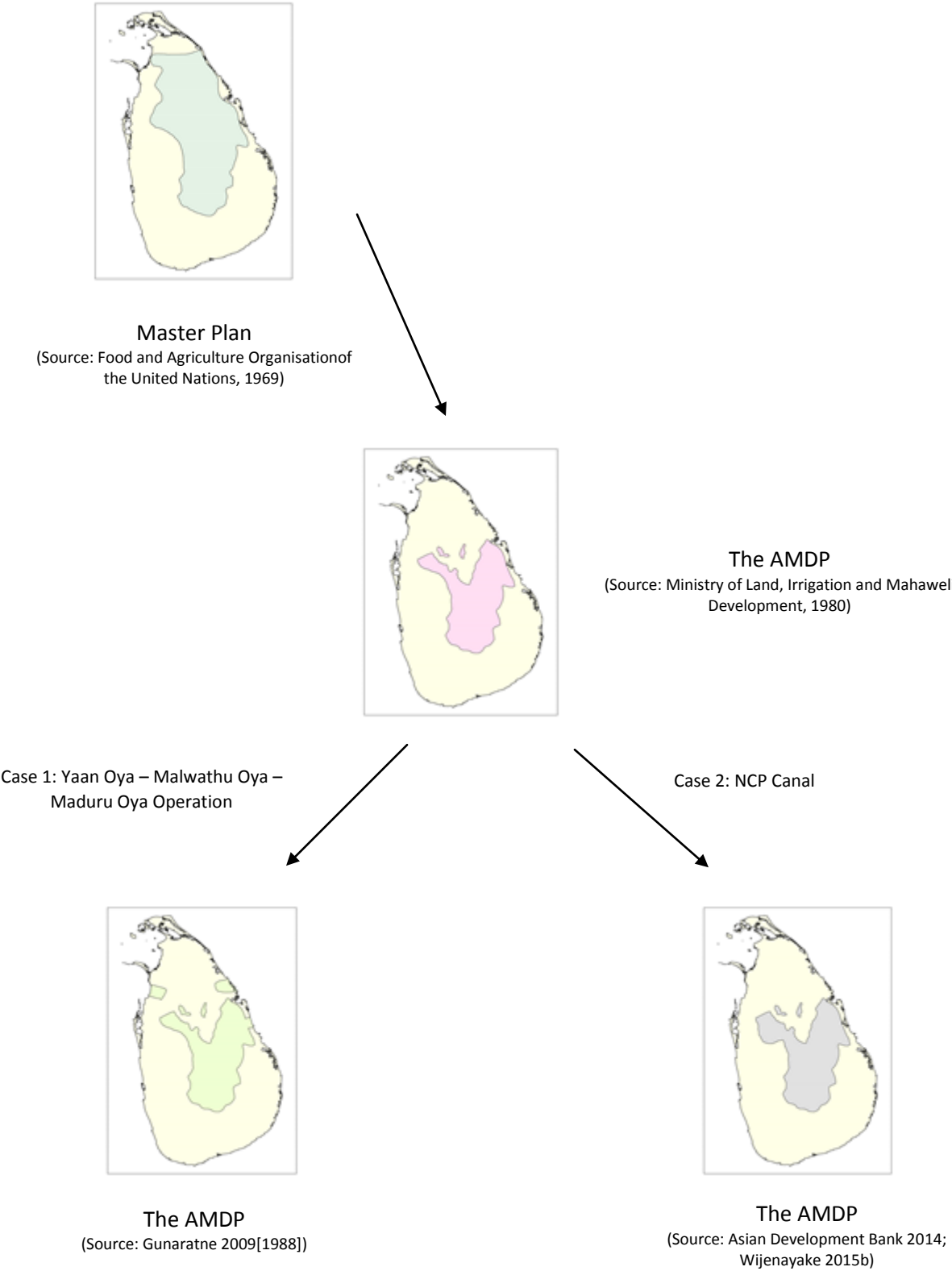

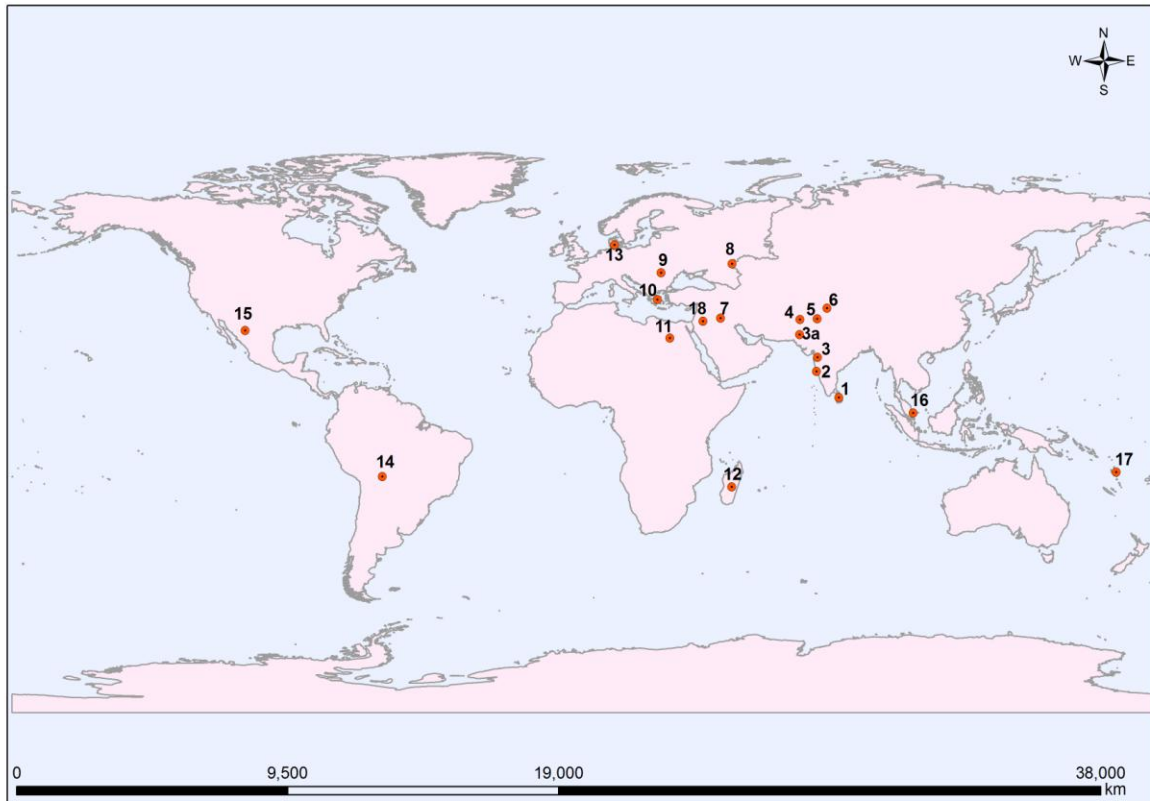
Map 2: A River for Jaffna
